

Louis Marie Grignion De Montfort was born on January 31, 1673 in a town called Montfort, in Western France. Today he ispopularly known as ST.MONTFORT. The Brothers of St. Gabriel Educational Society link their foundation to St. Louis Marie de Montfort (1673-1716) in France. In the course of his mission works, St. Louis Marie de Montfort established charitable schools for needy children. He entrusted this work to the early followers, from whom the group grew to be later known as the Brothers of St. Gabriel.




International YOGA DAY!



BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION








NATIONAL MONTFORT LITERARY & CULTURAL COMPETITIONS - 2021


Vermicomposting is the process by which earth worms are used to convert organic materials into vermi compost.
