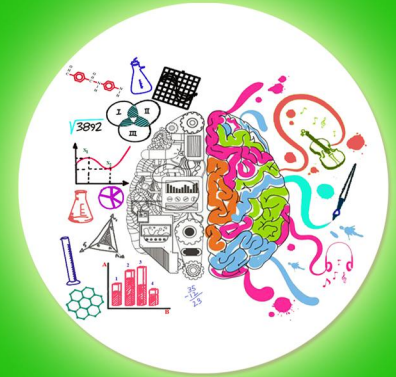

Louis Marie Grignon De Montfort was born on January 31, 1673 in a town called Montfort, in Western France. Today he is popularly known as **ST.MONTFORT**. The Brothers of St. Gabriel Educational Society link their foundation to St. Louis Marie de Montfort (1673-1716) in France. In the course of his mission works, St. Louis Marie de Montfort established charitable schools for needy children. He entrusted this work to the early followers, from whom the group grew to be later known as the **Brothers of St. Gabriel**.


VICE - PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Farewell cum Welcome Ceremony of Vice Principals







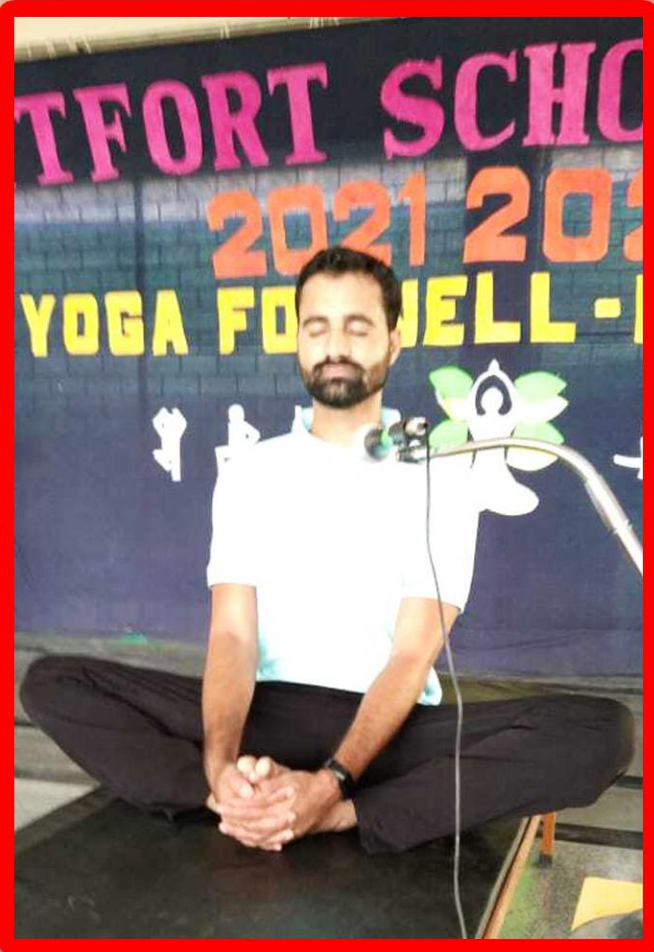
